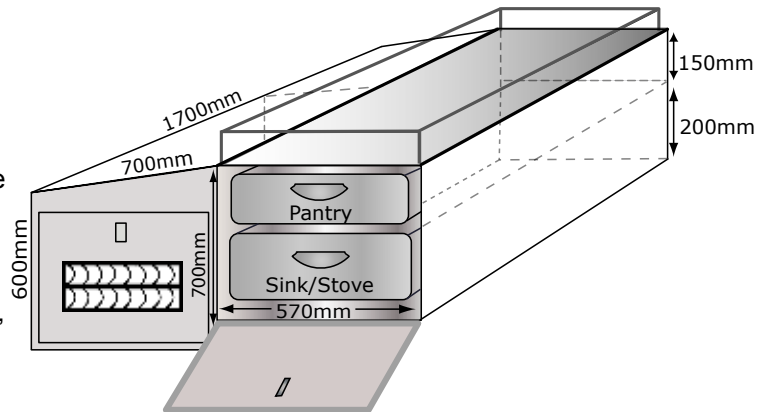


Aussie Swag Campers' durable and easy cleaning, stainless steel, slide-out pantry and swing-around kitchen make food preparation and cooking in the great outdoors quick and simple. Everything needed for cooking is within arm's reach.

Kitchen

The 100 litre storage area above the kitchen is best used as a pantry. It remains free from dust and insects and holds goods securely, preventing damage on rough roads. The pantry contains a sliding cutlery holder and a slide along bench.

The stainless steel kitchen has a large sink with electric water pump and flick mixer, draining board, preparation benches and a four burner flame failure stove with grill. Stainless steel wind guards are fitted around the stove burners, which together with the bi-fold windshield around the stove itself, helps reduce the effects of wind on cooking. Two 4kg gas bottles ensure you will never be out of gas, and for added peace of mind, the gas supply is automatically cut off when the kitchen is put away and turned on when the kitchen is opened. (Please note that the gas must be turned off at the bottle when travelling.)



The compartments under the sink and stove provide plenty of storage for your pots, pans, plates, bowls, cups and so on. A vinyl splash back attaches behind the sink to protect the canvas, and there is a 12 volt light above the sink. Also, items stored in the roof rack on top of the kitchen box do not need to be moved to open the trailer or access the kitchen and pantry.

A large, two compartment steel box is fitted to the draw bar in front of the kitchen. It is made from 1.2mm zinc aneal, is powder coated to match the kitchen and trailer, and has checker plate on top. The kitchen side of the box can carry an 80 litre *Waeco* fridge/freezer that slides out beside the pantry for easy, under cover access. The slide out fridge/freezer compartment is vented with filter foam for dusty conditions and has a 12 volt fan for improved refrigeration performance. When there is no fridge fitted, this area is used for extra storage. The second compartment is also vented with filter foam and houses a generator, tools, ropes, pegs and so on. An inbuilt electric hot water system can also be fitted here. A solar panel is carried on top of the fridge/storage box, allowing the camper to be opened without having to remove the panel. (A *Honda* EU 10i generator, 80L *Waeco* fridge, hot water system and 135 watt solar panel are standard on the *Ultra*.)
